Methods for Targeting:

The WY HAF Program keeps a close eye on applicants AMI percentage. Currently, over 65% of our recipients are at or below the 100% AMI threshold. The WY HAF Program stated in the WY HAF Grantee Plan that housing education services will be offered to those who are at or below 100% AMI and these services are available for those individuals. Wyoming has defined socially disadvantaged individuals as those with limited English proficiency and Tribal Members. Spanish flyers have been printed and posted to inform those with limited English proficiency of the available HAF funds. The WY HAF marketing and communications liaison has reached out to members of the Spanish speaking community in Wyoming to see what further outreach can be done to reach residents with limited English proficiency. The WY HAF Program works closely with the Wyoming Governor's office, who is the liaison for the Tribes in the State of Wyoming, to ensure the Tribes are aware of WY HAF funding and their ability to apply. Additional marketing has been done to target Fremont County where the Wyoming reservations are located.
